Organizacija UNESCO je uputila poziv za dostavljanje nominacija za novi ciklus UNESCO-Hamdan nagrade za razvoj nastavnika za period 2023-2024.

Inicijativa je nastala 2008. godine, a nagradu finansira Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum Fondacija iz Ujedinjenih Arapskih Emirata.

Nagrada se dodjeljuje svake dvije godine za tri odabrana laureata iz cijelog svijeta, u imponantnom iznosu od 100.000,00 dolara po svakom nagrađenom. Ima za cilj promociju profesionalizma, izvrsnosti i kvalitete nastavnog osoblja, unapređenje nastavne prakse širom svijeta, posebno u razvoju marginaliziranih i ugroženih zajednica, poboljšanjem programa obrazovanja nastavnika i njihovog profesionalnog razvoja. Nagrađuje kandidate koji su dali izuzetan doprinos poboljšanju kvaliteta nastave, učenja i podučavanja.

Nominirani kandidati mogu biti institucije, organizacije, kao i obrazovne ili istraživačke institucije, a svaka država može nominovati do 5 kandidata.

U cilju dobijanja eventualnog pisma preporuke, prijedloge projekata za kandidaturu potrebno je dostaviti **najkasnije do 04. 09. 2023. godine** na adresu:

uz napomenu „Za nagradu UNESCO-Hamdan 2023-2024 za razvoj nastavnika“

Prijedlog projekta za kandidaturu, na engleskom jeziku, treba da sadrži: detaljan opis i rezultate projekta uz prateće materijale sa navedenim trajanjem projekta (početak i završetak), uz **obaveznu preporuku nadležnog ministarstva**.

Napominjemo da projekti mogu biti isključivo institucionalni ili organizacijski, te da se samonominacije neće razmatrati. Također, projekti trebaju imati značajan doprinos unapređenju učenja i podučavanja u skladu sa UNESCO principima i ciljevima u ovoj oblasti i u vrijeme podnošenja aplikacije njihova realizacija treba biti u toku najmanje 3 godine.

Podržane kandidature za nagradu (na engleskom ili francuskom jeziku) se dostavljaju putem online platforme na stranici UNESCO-Hamdan Prize for Teacher Development | UNESCO na kojoj se mogu pronaći detaljnije informacije o kriterijima i načinima apliciranja.

Krajnji rok za podnošenje aplikacija je **31. 10. 2023. godine**.

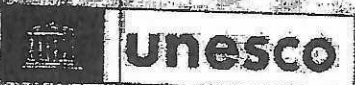

UNESCO-Hamdan Prize for Teacher Development

Call for applications and nominations 2023

Deadline: 31 October 2023

The UNESCO-Hamdan Prize for Teacher Development was created in 2008 to support the improvement of teaching and learning quality in achieving the Sustainable Development Goal 4 on quality education, which is one of UNESCO's priorities.

The Prize is awarded every two years to three winners whose projects aim at improving the performance and effectiveness of teachers worldwide.

It is generously supported by the Hamdan Foundation in the United Arab Emirates, and amounts to US \$300,000, which is equally divided between the three winners.



Who is eligible to apply?

- Institutions or organizations: international or national governmental or non-governmental organizations; educational or research institutions active in the field of teaching and learning.
- Candidate organizations and institutions nominated by an official nominating body:
 1. Member States in consultation with their National Commissions
 2. Non-governmental organizations in official partnership with UNESCO active in a field covered by the Prize.
- Applications must be submitted in English or in French only.
- Only organizations and institutions' projects will be considered. Self-nominations are not eligible for the Prize and will not be considered.

What are the conditions of the project's eligibility?

1. The project must have made a significant contribution to enhancing teaching and learning, in line with UNESCO's principles and objectives in this field.
2. The project must be exemplary and likely to stimulate similar initiatives; it must have shown itself to be effective in mobilizing new intellectual and material resources.
3. The project must be ongoing for at least three years at the time of the application.

How to nominate a project?

Nominations can be submitted in two ways:

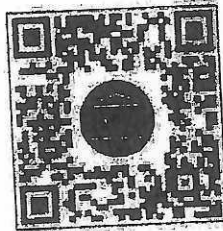
1. Candidates may contact the National Commission for UNESCO of their country or a non-governmental organization in official partnership with UNESCO, and active in a field covered by the Prize, to request a nomination letter;
2. Nominating bodies identify nominees and send them a nomination letter.

Each body can nominate up to 5 candidates before the deadline, and the nomination letter must comply with the Prize requirements. The nomination letter must be uploaded by the candidate in the online platform. In exceptional cases, where candidates do not have access to Internet, nominating bodies can request access to the online platform to submit the candidate nomination and application.

How to apply?

1. Candidates must register online to request an account. In doing so, candidates must comply with the eligibility requirements.
2. After registration is completed, only eligible candidates will receive an invitation link via email to access and complete the online application form.
3. Candidates will receive an email notification once they submit their application. The nominating body also receives an automatic notification of the candidate application.
4. Once the finalized application is received by the UNESCO Secretariat, the application process is complete.

When is the deadline to apply?

The deadline for applications is **31 October 2023** (midnight, Paris time). The online platform will be closed after the deadline.

Selection process

1. The Prize Secretariat reviews all applications received before the deadline and transmits the eligible applications to the International Jury of the Prize.
2. The International Jury meets in-person to assess the applications.
3. UNESCO's Director-General selects the three winners based on the recommendations of the International Jury.
4. The Prize is awarded to the winners during an official ceremony organized on 5 October 2024, on World Teachers' Day, at UNESCO Headquarters in Paris (France).
